

## How to Clean Naturally

I have tested all of these and for the most part they work. ALWAYS test on a hidden area first to make sure what you are using is safe for the thing you are cleaning. Also make sure you or a member of your house hold doesn't have allergies to these or any products.

Remember just because something is natural doesn't mean it's totally safe. All of these are chemicals and can be dangerous if ingested. Remember to read labels and follow all safety warnings. Reducing the number and kinds of productions in your home make it a safer place but you MUST also store them properly on a very high self or in a locked cabinet for the safety of children and pets.

### Material's list

Borax	Washing Soda	Lemons
Oxy-Clean (Dollar Store brand)	Citric Acid (Store brand Kool-Aid)	Lemon Juice
White Vinegar	Baking Soda	Olive Oil
Salt	Essential Oils	Bleach

### Dishwasher Powder:

1 cup Washing soda 1cup Borax <i>Mix well (don't use Food Processor)</i>	Use 1.5 Tbl per load Works ok. Pits AL
1 cup Borax 1 cup Baking Soda ¼ cup salt 3 packs of Citric Acid ½ cup Oxy-Clean <i>Mix well (don't use Food Processor)</i>	Use 2 Tbl per load Works the best of all that I tried.
2 Tbl Baking Soda 4 drops of bleach <i>Put 2 Tbl spoons in cups with drops of bleach on top.</i>	Works well on loads that have sat awhile.

### Floor Cleaner:

2 Tbl Washing Soda 1Gal warm water	Works well on Linoleum. Rinse well.
1 Cup of White Vinegar 10 Drops of olive oil 1 Gal of Warm Water	Works well on Tile. Rinse Well!!

1 Cup of White Vinegar 10 Drops of Olive Oil ½ Cup of Borax 1Gal of Warm Water	Will take the finish off your floors!!! Cleans grout well. Rinse Well.
¼ Cup White Vinegar 1Gal Warm Water	Works well on wood Floors.

**General Cleaners:**

½ Cup Borax 1Gal Hot Water <i>Mix well</i> <i>Wait to cool</i>	Works well. Use gloves – Borax is natural but dangerous.
Hot Water	Scrub like Hell. Works very well.
½ Cup Vinegar ¼ Baking Soda ½ Gal of warm water <i>Mix well</i>	Use on most surfaces. Streaks bad on mirrors but does work.
½ Cup Vinegar ¼ Borax ½ Gal of warm water <i>Mix well</i>	Use on most surfaces. Streaks bad on mirrors but does work.
1 Cup White Vinegar 1Cup Water <i>Put in Spray bottle</i>	Works very well. Streaks bad on mirrors.
1 Tsp Washing Soda 1 Gal of Water <i>Put in Spray Bottle</i>	Leaves a film.

**Metal Polish:**

2 Tbs Salt White Vinegar till paste <i>Rub on surface till clean</i>	Lots of elbow grease. Did well Copper
Baking Soda White Vinegar <i>Cover in Baking Soda dampen with Vinegar</i> <i>Rub like Hell</i>	Lots of elbow grease. Stainless Steel
Tooth Paste <i>Rub like Hell</i>	Lots of elbow grease Work very well. Silver
Aluminum Foil	Works good. Take off heat after you up in

1 Tea Baking Soda 1 Tea Salt Boil put in silver Polish	Silver.

**Toilet Cleaner:**

¼ Cup Baking Soda 1 Cup Vinegar <i>Pour into Toilet</i> <i>Let set</i> <i>Scrub &amp; Rinse</i>	Works VERY Well.
1 Cup Borax ½ Lemon Juice <i>Pour into Toilet</i> <i>Let set</i> <i>Scrub &amp; Rinse</i>	Works VERY well.
½ Cup Baking Soda ½ lemon Juice <i>Pour into Toilet</i> <i>Let set</i> <i>Scrub &amp; Rinse</i>	Works ok but makes you bath smell good.

**Drain Cleaner/ Garbage Disposal:**

½ Cup Washing Soda 2 Cups Boiling Water <i>Pouring Soda in drain</i> <i>Chase with Hot water</i> <i>Let sit 20min then More hot water</i>	Works Well!!!
Cut Lemon in half <i>Run both halves through the Disposal</i>	Works well. Makes the Kitchen smell like lemons.
½ Cup Salt 1 Gal of water <i>Heat (not to boiling or will melt pipes)</i> <i>Pour down the drain</i> <i>Wait 20 min then flush</i>	Works ok.
½ Cup Baking Soda ½ Cup Vinegar <i>Pour down the drain</i> <i>Wait 20 min then flush</i>	Works very
